## City in Transition Roberto Camagni

Roberto Camagni is Emeritus Professor of Regional and Urban Economics at Politecnico di Milano. Past President of the European Regional Science Association-ERSA and of the Italian Regional Science Association AISRe, has published a textbook of Urban Economics in Italian, French and Spanish and is the author of more than 150 international scientific publications and more than 150 national publications. Served as Head of the Department for Urban Affairs at the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, Rome, under the Prodi Government, 1997-98, and was Vice-president of the Group on Urban Affairs of OECD, Paris, 1998. Has worked for the European Commission, the OECD, the French DATAR, the Italian Ministries of Public Works and of European Affairs, the ESPON project in the fields of innovation diffusion, strategic planning, regional forecasting modelling, territorial impact assessment. In 2017 was elected Fellow of the Regional Science Association International. In 2010 was awarded the ERSA / EIB Prize and in 2008 the Prize of the Fondazione Confalonieri, Milan, for his studies in urban sustainable development.
